



Code of practice for staff, volunteer and attendees to Sidh C Art Events

- Be positive and give praise where possible. Treat everyone with respect and courtesy.
- Note that no form of bullying will be tolerated.
- Prevent discrimination when you encounter it.
- Be an excellent role model in terms of language and behaviour.
- Never be in situations where you and just one child (person under 18) is present, e.g. one-to-one coaching in closed rooms.
- Never have any private communication in person or online with participants who are under 18.
- Do not share digital content (images etc) of under 18s without prior consent from a parent or carer.
